- To gain knowledge about the ideas of intellectual property rights

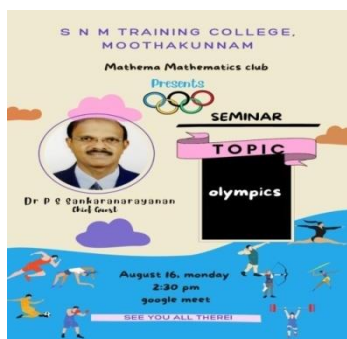

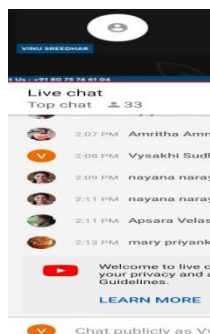
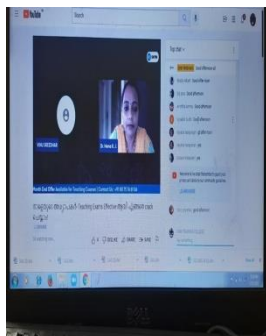
'NALEYUDEADHYAPAKAR' - HOW TO CRACK TEACHING EXAMS EFFECTIVELY?

- Strategies to promote teacher professionalism

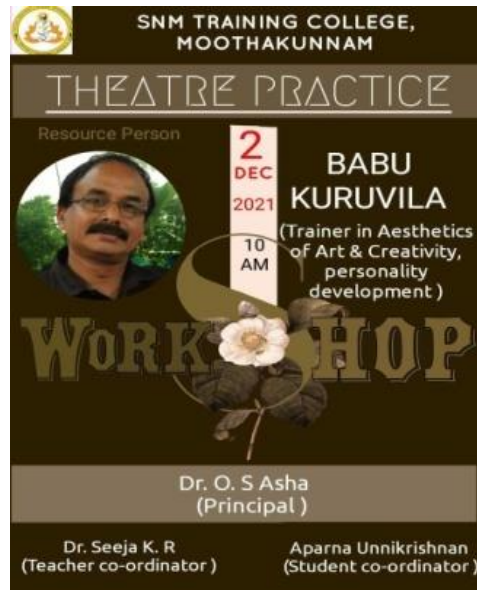

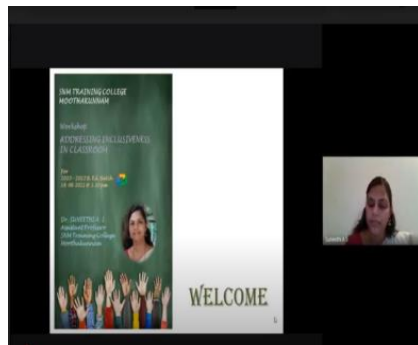
WORKSHOP ON ADDRESSING INCLUSIVENESS IN CLASSROOM

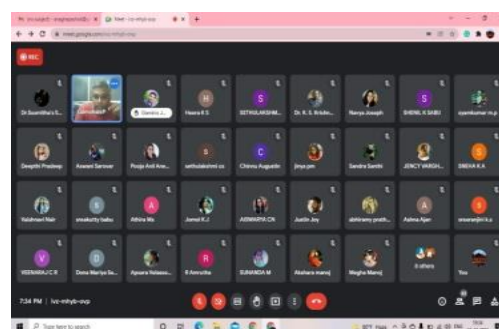

- To enhances the approaches towards public relation

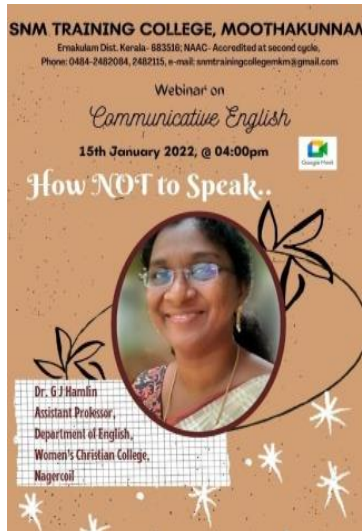

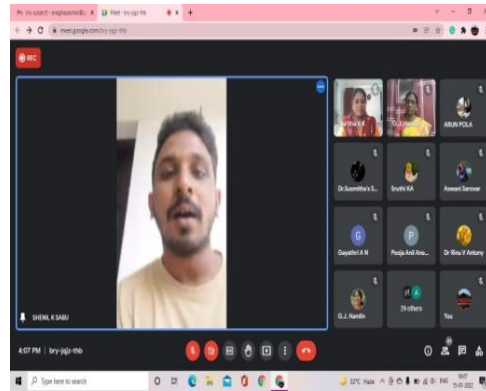
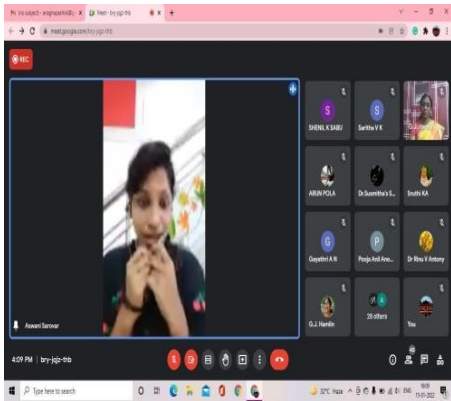


Aim

She elaborated the importance of content mapping which emphasizes specialized content knowledge by organizing and sequencing the instructional tasks. Content maps have a variety of uses in supporting the professional development of teachers, including serving as a tool that allows teachers to define the content to be taught in an instructional unit, a teaching tool that can be used to teach content knowledge, and an assessment tool to assess the content knowledge of preservice and inservice teachers.

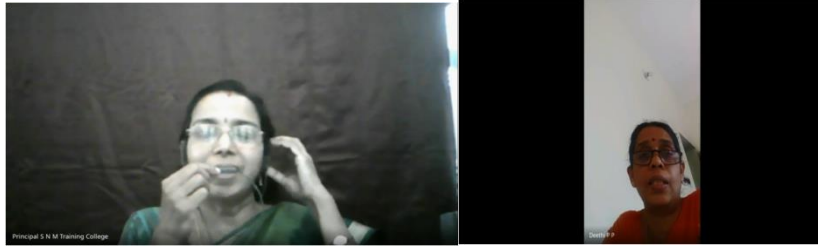

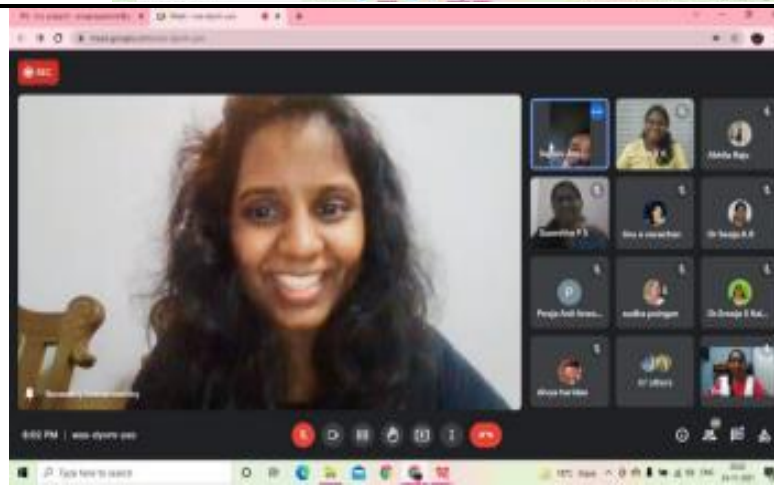


WEBINAR ON HOLISTIC WELLNESS

She also added upon the TheCrimes identified under the Special Laws (SLL) with the Employees State Insurance Act, 1948, The Special Marriage Act, 1954, The Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, The Hindu Succession Act, 1956 with amendment in 2005, Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act, 1956, Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961, The Medical Termination of Pregnancy Act, 1971, The Equal Remuneration Act, 1976, The Prohibition of Child Marriage Act, 2006, Indecent Representation of Women (Prohibition) Act, 1986, The Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005. The whole session brought insight regarding the gender equality and the laws and regulations that support all the genders from inequality, violations or abuse. She marked out how the teachers have the key role to understand the children their problems and make solutions or provide necessary support and help in need at situations.

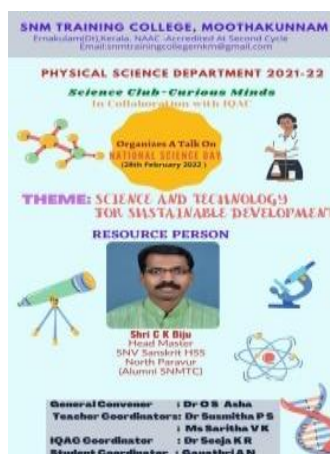
