



- To create awareness regarding the need for conserving the environment.


World environment day celebration was very beneficial and informative to spread awareness about the significance of environment day and the conservation of the environment for a better future.


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

The class was interesting and informative and useful in giving us ideas for choosing learning resources for upcoming classroom activities as well as our future careers in education.






ORIENTATION TO SCHOOL HEAD TEACHERS/PRINCIPALS-2021-2023 BATCH







DR SUSMITHA P S (PRINCIPAL SNM TRAINING COLLEGE, MOOTHAKUNNAM).






SESSION ON YOGA





The final session was handled by Dr.Hareesh N Ramanathan, Associate Professor, CUSAT.He presented the topic "Design of Experiments".






ORIENTATION OF M ED

17-03-2023




AIM

- To clarify students, concern regarding crimes related ti educational field.










WEBINAR - CLIMATE CHANGE AND IT'S IMPACTS








CARDIO PULOMONARY RESUSCITATION SKILL TRAINING
